LJ v SHoC et al Respondents Vote: No EoP TRC.

[1] Summary of Application Negotiations:

[2] On 07 October 2019 applicant electronically filed Direct EoP Pro Se Application requesting ‘EoP or WiP’ Legal Certainty Clarification of 23 June 2016 Brexit Referendum and 01 May 2019 House of Commons Climate Emergency

Declaration; for Applicant & EU President Respondent in ZA: Grg H 111/19: LJ v LS & 8 Others, with the UK Supreme Court Registry office.

[3] Among others the application requested an order confirming:

- [3.1] [I] All Respondents Receipt of Ecology of Peace (“EoP”) Truth and Reconciliation (“TRC”) – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law (“Exit”) – UN Resolution negotiations documentation; excerpts of H 111/19: LJ v Lindiwe Sisulu application requesting EoP – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law / Climate & Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution to be submitted to UN General Assembly to authorize EoP Scientific and Cultural law be implemented as binding international law.
- [3.2] [II] Applicants Request to Speaker (01st to 05th) Respondents to consent to ‘EoP TRC Exit’ and submit EoP UN Resolution documentation to their legislative council requesting their AYE: Consent or NAY: Object vote with regard to Ecology of Peace – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law / Climate and Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution Declaration.
- [3.3] [III] Applicants Request to Leaders of UK Political Parties and Extinction Rebellion (06th to 07th) Respondents to consent to ‘EoP TRC Exit’ and submit EoP UN Resolution documentation to their political and protest party membership requesting their AYE: Consent or NAY: Object vote with regard to Ecology of Peace – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law / Climate and Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution Declaration.

[4] On 10 October 2019, the UK Supreme Court Registrar responded acknowledging receipt and declining to accept the application because “claims and originating applications cannot be issued in this Court’.

[5] Applicant applied to various lower UK Courts:

- [5.1] 12 October 2019 Gloucestershire Court, London and Westminster Court
- [5.2] 20 October 2019: Northern Ireland Royal Courts of Justice.

[A] On 23 October 2019 the Office of the Lord Chief Justice of Northern Ireland responded that Ecology of Peace category of court was not available in Northern Ireland Royal Courts of Justice jurisdiction.

[6] Applicant notified cases already in UK courts dealing with similar issues:

- [6.1] 22 October 2019: Upper Tribunal: Immigration and Asylum Chamber: Appeal: EA/06667/2016: JP/E de Souza v Home Secretary: A case dealing with the Good Friday Agreement.
- [6.2] 23 October 2019: UK-US-SE v Julian Assange cases.
- [6.3] 23 October 2019: UK v Ann Sacoolas.

- [7.2] Solicitors Regulation Authority: CEO: Paul Philip
- [7.3] Ofcom: CEO: Sharon White

[8] Conclusion: No EoP TRC:

- [8.1] All Respondents were electronically notified of Ecology of Peace (“EoP”) Truth and Reconciliation (“TRC”) – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law (“Exit”) – UN Resolution negotiations documentation; excerpts of H 111/19: LJ v Lindiwe Sisulu application requesting EoP – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law / Climate & Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution to be submitted to UN General Assembly to authorize EoP Scientific and Cultural law be implemented as binding international law.
- [8.2] Speaker (01st to 05th) and Leaders of UK Political Parties and Extinction Rebellion (06th to 07th) Respondents declined to voluntarily submit EoP UN Resolution documentation to their legislative council/political and protest parties for Ecology of Peace – Exit Babylon Ecocide Law / Climate and Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution Declaration vote.
- [8.3] None of the respondents had any questions about EoP UN Resolution.
- [8.4] None of the respondents had any edit suggestions for EoP UN Resolution.

[9] Respondents object to Applicants H 111/19: LJ v Lindiwe Sisulu Ecology of Peace – EoP Brexit: Exit Babylon Ecocide Law: Climate and Ecological Emergency – UN Resolution draft text and definitions to implement EoP Scientific and Cultural law based on EoP Footprint as binding international law; to enable Ecology of Peace Truth and Reconciliation (“EoP TRC”) to End Abel and Kane Cold War to [A] enable responsible freedom orderly and humane – de-industrialization and depopulation, prisoner release, land reform and denuclearization – shut down of the Babylon War is Peace Ponzi Swamp economy; [B] require all citizens of all races, religions, nations, to breed and consume below ecological carrying capacity limits; or be humanely eliminated from the planetary genepool; [C] nationalize all property and provide all responsible freedom oath citizens: (i) with cultural law self rule for groups with subjective racial, religious & gender identities; and (ii) a property ration land reform to enable their shelter and survival self-sufficiency to enable the rebuilding of a relocalized low-tech organic agrarian sustainable future.

[10] In the context of H 111/19: LJ v Lindiwe Sisulu EoP TRC or No EoP TRC application; respondents vote No EoP TRC.

An Order confirming Respondents – on behalf of the organization or Head of State they represent – Consent / Edit / Objection Response to:

[A] Authorize EoP PoW TRC to End Abel and Kane Cold War Negotiations: Ecology of Peace Truth and Reconciliation (“EoP TRC”) to End Abel and Kane Cold War negotiations to implement EoP Scientific and Cultural law as international law; by process of EoP UN Resolution; to [A] enable responsible freedom orderly and humane – de-industrialization and depopulation, prisoner release [prisoner-pardon], land reform and denuclearization – shut down of the WiP Ponzi Swamp economy; [B] require all citizens of all races, religions, nations, to breed and consume below ecological carrying capacity limits; or be humanely eliminated from the planetary genepool; [C] nationalize all property and provide all responsible freedom oath citizens: (i) with cultural law self rule

for groups with subjective racial, religious & gender identities; and (ii) a property ration land reform to enable their shelter and survival self-sufficiency to enable the rebuilding of a relocalized low-tech organic agrarian sustainable future.

[B] If EoP TRC: Authorize EoP – Sustainable Security / Climate Change & Ecological Overshoot Emergency - UN Resolution:
Ecology of Peace recommended: [A] UN Security Council and General Assembly Resolution to Implement Ecology of Peace Scientific and Cultural law as international law; [B] Suggested Amendment to Crime of Aggression Definition of Rome Statute of International Criminal Court.

[C] If No EoP TRC: Authorize US v McVeigh Siberia PoW Suicide:
Logistics: (a) Respondent Lapenn on behalf of Respondent NSA: Gen Paul Nakasone and/or Timothy McVeigh's NSA superior; authorizing the release of Timothy McVeigh to travel to South Africa and to Russia with applicant for their joint assisted suicide in Siberia; (b) Respondent Lapenn and Respondent Petrakov on behalf of Respondent NSA Dir Gen Paul Nakasone and Respondent FSB Dir Gen Alexander Bortnikov negotiating the authorized release of Timothy McVeigh to travel to South Africa and to Russia with applicant for their joint assisted suicide in Siberia; (c) Respondent Sisulu authorizing a visa for Timothy McVeigh to travel to Russia via South Africa; (d) Respondent Petrakov issuing a visa for Applicant and Timothy McVeigh to travel to Russia for their assisted suicide departure in unmarked graves in the Siberian wilderness.
